

**Completion/Graduation Rate Disclosures per 34 CFR 668.45  
July 1, 2023**

Neumont College of Computer Science provides complete graduation, retention and other statistics to the general public, including prospective students, as required by the US Department of Education (“ED”) via the integrated Postsecondary Educational Data System (“IPEDS”). This is the latest graduation rate based on the IPEDS report. These statistics are for full time, first time students (FTFT) who began their studies In the Full-Year Cohort of 2016 and graduated within 150% of the “normal time” to complete their program.
